## THE HOLY SEASON OF LENT

Lent is a season of solemn religious observance in the Christian liturgical calendar that began last Wednesday (Ash Wednesday) and ends approximately six weeks later, before Easter Sunday. The purpose of Lent is the preparation of the believer for Easter through prayer, doing penance, repentance of sins, almsgiving, and self-denial.

Lent comes to its climax in Holy Week marking the path, burial, and resurrection of Jesus, which recalls the tradition and events of the New Testament beginning on Palm Sunday, further climaxing on Jesus's crucifixion on Good Friday, which ultimately culminates in the joyful celebration on Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of Jesus Christ.

In Lent, we are encouraged to commit to fasting, as well as giving up certain luxuries in order to replicate the sacrifice of Jesus Christ's journey into the desert for 40 days. Further encouragement is also given to adding a Lenten spiritual discipline, such as reading a daily devotional book.

The **Stations of the Cross (Fridays of Lent at 7 pm)** will help us in our Lenten preparations for Easter. God bless you in your Lenten observance.

All through the season of Lent here at St Philip the Apostle an **evening Mass will be celebrated at 7.30pm from Monday - Friday**. All are welcome. Also early morning Mass will be at 7.00 am Monday to Friday in **St Ciarans, Hartstown**
